Pre-EUG Basic and Advanced User/Administrator Training Syllabus:

This two-day course covers both basic and advanced features of Empower. Whether you are a current user or want to enhance your knowledge of Empower, we urge you to register for this in-depth class. You will learn:

- Importing data into Empower from various sources such as JSON (IPMDAR or DOE CPP), DoD IPMR, DOE Standardized EV Cost and Schedule Data files, wInsight XML, X12, Microsoft Project, Oracle P6, and Microsoft Excel
- Recalculation options and applying management thresholds
- Preparing for DCMA DECM and DOE data-driven audits using Empower
- Integrated Cost and IMS analytics
- Grouping and analyzing portfolios of projects
- Creating custom Dashboards
- Configuring Empower to support VAR narrative collection, tracking, and approval with Empower's workflow and email notification system
- Configuring Empower to support corrective action tracking and approval with Empower's workflow and email notification system
- Integrating Corrective Action tracking with VAR reporting in Empower

Pre-EUG Utilizing Empower's Advanced Features Training Syllabus:

This one-day course covers advanced features of Empower. The following topics will be covered:

- IPMDAR JSON file export configuration and export options
- Enhanced schedule analysis using Task Mode, Schedule Execution Metrics, etc.
- Proper configuration of Audit Metric settings
- Validating audit metrics hits in the Sort Window
- Optimizing VAR collection, approval, and submissions
- Understanding performance data at the Work Package level when collecting actual costs at the Control Account
- Contract specific narrative templates

Note: as this is a new course offering, the syllabus may evolve as the training course is developed, but the course will focus on 6-8 advanced features of Empower. The goal is for the user to understand the features and how to maximize use of those features.

Pre-EUG Humphreys & Associates Scalable EVM Course

This one-day course provides an introduction to scaling the basic EVMS principles to match the level of data detail and control rigor based on the type of project, scope of work, complexity, duration, and risk factors. Corporations often desire to implement EVM practices on a broad range of projects to improve project visibility and control for project portfolio analysis. Not all of the EIA-748 Standard for EVMS Guidelines would be applicable on smaller less complex projects where compliance with the EIA-748 is not required. That said, there are some commonsense rules that should be enforced for a



scaled EVM application to ensure sound management information is being provided to internal management, so they have timely and relevant information to make information decisions. This workshop discusses how EVM practices can be scaled to support management objectives for better project visibility and control. Using the framework of the EIA-748 guideline process areas, this workshop focuses on the core EVM practices and approaches for scaling them to fit the management needs for a given project.

Pre-EUG DOE/ASU IP2M METRR Facilitator Certification Course

IP2M METRR Facilitator Certification Program

Learn how to facilitate the implementation of the Integrated Project/Program Management (IP2M) Maturity and Environment Total Risk Rating (METRR) tool that is rapidly becoming the default mechanism to assess the effectiveness of Earned Value Management Systems (EVMS) execution. IP2M METRR's assessment of EVMS has been statistically correlated with cost and schedule performances. The two-day training is the first step towards certification. It focuses on IP2M METRR implementation and content, including its environment and maturity components, and the facilitation skills for effective assessment sessions, such as the facilitator's role, how to facilitate a session, and team dynamics. Participants will gain and apply insights on facilitation and the IP2M METRR tool, and complete a written exam.

After the training, participants will submit a case study based on a facilitated session experience as the second and final step towards certification. Arizona State University will award the certification upon completing the program (two-day training and case study).

Facilitator Certification Program

Participants will be certified as IP2M METRR facilitators upon completing the program.

All Empower training sessions require a laptop computer with Wi-Fi capability.
